Governor Inspects Newly Sworn In Police Officers.



The annual Governor's Inspection of newly sworn-in police officers took place on Friday, February 28, 2025, at the Department of Public Safety Main Station in Fagatogo. The inspection was officiated by Police Commissioner HTC Taagaiafeai Saite Moliga and Honorable Governor Pulaali'i Nikolao Pula, with Lieutenant Governor Pulumataala Ae Ae Jr. also in attendance. The ceremony commenced with a prayer led by Pastor Bam Lauvao, followed by Governor Pulaali'i conducting the inspection. During his remarks, Governor Pulaali'i conveyed his appreciation to the newly sworn-in officers for their commitment to public safety, highlighting the significance of their duty in safeguarding and serving the community.
