
All Cabinet members and Acting Directors are encouraged to attend both events. Please refer to the attached program for specific details. Please plan to arrive 30 minutes early.


Let us come together to pay tribute to these brave men and women who have made sacrifices so that our freedoms and way of life may be preserved.




