General Description:

The Environmental Specialist II (ESII) of the Safe Drinking Water Branch – Water Program performs a wide range of technical tasks in the Safe Drinking Water (SDW) Branch including sanitary survey inspection, bottling water facility inspections, water vending machines, compliance determinations, regulatory enforcement and non-point source pollution prevention activities as directed by the Safe Drinking Water Branch Chief.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- Using Extensive technical knowledge, experience, and appropriate equipment, conducts sanitary surveys of all Public Water System components including water sources, treatment facilities, distribution systems, finished water storage structures, pump stations and controls.
- Monitors Public Water system reporting, management and operations, and operator compliance with the American Samoa and Federal Safe Drinking Water Regulations.
- Determines regulatory compliance with SDW regulation requirements and initiates enforcement actions including Notice of Violations and Administrative Order as needed.
- Develops and coordinates environmental education outreach and media activities in relation to drinking water issues with Program Manager and Environmental Awareness and Education Program.
