- WHEREAS, the depth and breadth of the nursing profession equips nurses in American Samoa to meet diverse and emerging health care needs across clinics, hospitals, homes, schools, and community outreach settings; and
- WHEREAS, the American Samoa Nurses Association, as the voice and advocate for all nurses across the territory, is leading efforts to strengthen our health care system by promoting greater access to primary and preventative care especially for underserved and remote communities; and
