**General Description:**

**Key Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Airport Firefighter I receives concentrated training in Aircraft Fire Rescue Firefighting work and perform routine duties as a part of their training and assume additional responsibilities as their knowledge and skills development
- Responds to fires, aircraft emergencies, medical aid calls, hazmat incidents, vehicle accidents, and other emergency situations
- Conducting routine maintenance work aiming to vehicle and vessel engine functionally and longevity
- Renders aids and basic life support services; rescues and assists persons from aircraft and structures
- Performs assigned training ensuring compliance with federal and local requirements
- Assists in performing airport fire inspections' enforces fire and life safety codes; completes fire inspections documentation; and reports violations to supervisors

- Performs dispatching duties and must also pass Pr-Board exam
- Participates in emergency drills and training courses in firefighting techniques and other emergency vehicles and equipment; reports discrepancies to watch commander or supervisor; and operates and inspects communication equipment
- Maintains fire station and performs minor custodial and maintenance duties and washes vehicles
- Perform other job-related duties as assigned
