

## Test-to-Treat Locations & Schedule: April 25 - 30.

Test-to-Treat locations throughout the week: Tafuna Health Center ACF 1, Amouli and Leone Health Centers from 8 AM-4 PM. Testing and therapeutic treatment will also be available Saturday 8 AM - 2 PM at Tafuna CHC only. All positive cases are now directed to 10 days of Home Isolation. Therapeutic treatments must be administered within the first few days of illness to be effective.
