O le molimau a le Afioga Paia a le Atua, “O fanau ua fa'atusaina o ni ū fanafana i le lima o le Toa, o tama'i Olive foi latou te vagavagaia luga o le lao'ai, auā o i latou o le tofi o mātua mai le Atua.” O le fa'asinomaga tāua lenā o fanau i lō latou vā fa'afeagai ai ma matua. Ae a fua i lō tatou soifuaga fa'a-Samoa, o āu o mātua o fanau, auā e fai aso ma tagialao i o latou mana'oga.

Ua sauni mātua e tu'uina atu se fa'aeaea maualuga mo i latou e ala i lō tatou tali atu e fa'amalie ma fa'afiafia nai fanau a'o tapena ai le latou Aso Sā Pa'epa'e. E fa'atasi i le tausaga ona fa'ailoga le lotu tamaiti, ae o le tele ia o tatou fa'alavelave e fai i aso uma. Ia sasa'a pea lō tatou soifua ta'uaogāina mo le tausiga o 'oloa tāua mai le Atua. Auā o a tatou galuega lelei mātua, e toe mulimuli atu ia te'i latou i le lumana'i.
