## **Health Advisories**

### Situational Summary

On March 03, 2022, a total of 245 tests were conducted, among these, 19 tested positive. There are no reported hospitalizations or deaths due to COVID-19. Those who test positive are served with a Home Isolation Directive for 14 days. All family members of the same household are considered close contacts and will be served with a 14-day Home Quarantine Directive. Enforcement of Home Isolation and Quarantine will be conducted by the Department of Public Safety and Office of Samoan Affairs, in cooperation with DOH.

COVID-19 Testing is available on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8 am- 2 pm at Amouli Clinic, Tafuna Family Health Center, and Leone Clinic. COVID-19 vaccines are scheduled on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 8 am - 2 pm at Samoana High School, Tafuna DYWA, and Leone Catholic Hall. The Drive-Thru COVID Vaccination Clinic is scheduled for Saturday March 5, 2022 from 8 am - 2 pm at the Tafuna Airport. The public is advised to bring their vaccination cards. Space is limited.

Anticipate long lines at each drive-thru and walk-in vaccination clinic site. DOH asks that all residents wear a mask and maintain a safe physical distance from others at all times. Please comply with the directions of DOH vaccine support staff during the entire COVID vaccination process.
