


## Situational Summary

On March 08, 2022, about 552 tests were conducted, of these, 52 individuals tested positive. There are no new hospitalizations to report that are due to COVID-19. DOH reminds the community that those who test positive are served with a Home Isolation Directive. Anyone with COVID-19 must separate themselves from other people, this may include others in their home. If you know someone who tested positive, let them know that you care by sending text messages, video messages, or groceries their way.

On Tuesday, March 8, about 1,569 doses were administered at the COVID-19 Vaccination sites, of these, about 1,456 doses were boosters.

## **Upcoming Events**

COVID-19 vaccines will be available from 8 AM - 4 PM, Tuesday through Friday at DYWA in Pago and at the Leone Catholic Hall. COVID-19 vaccines will be available at Tafuna DYWA from 8AM - 8 PM.

COVID-19 testing sites are open from 8 AM - 4 PM, Monday to Friday at the health centers in Amouli, and Leone. Tafuna Health Center will be open from 8 AM to 8 PM to provide COVID-19 tests after hours.

Please note that the extended-hours schedule for both testing and vaccination sites is subject to change.
