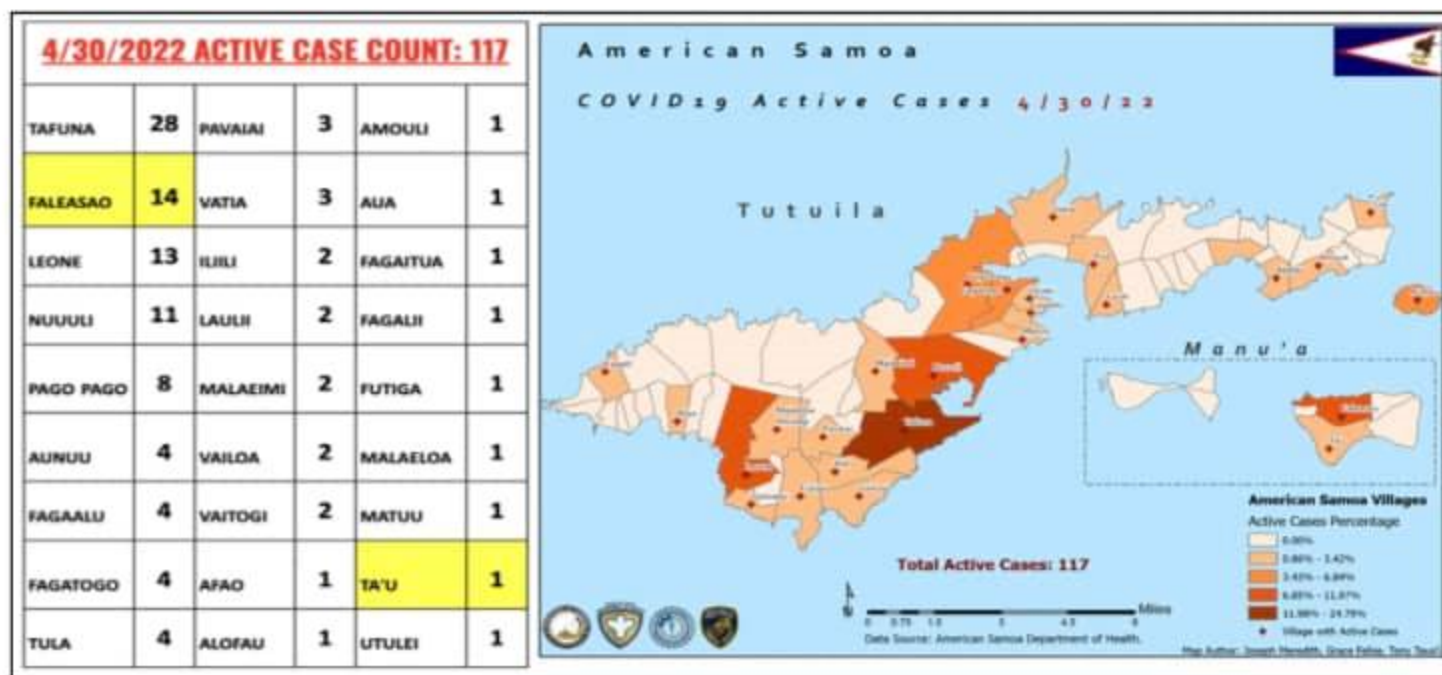

Clinic Schedule:

COVID-19 Vaccines will be available at Amouli and Leone Health Centers and Tafuna DYWA from 8AM-4PM on Monday-Wednesday, and 8AM-12 PM on Thursday. Vaccination sites will be closed on Friday. Saturday sites will be announced once confirmed. Routine children vaccinations are still available at Fagaalu, Leone and Tafuna Health Centers, please call for an appointment. Bicillin prophylaxis are available on Tuesdays and Thursdays at Tafuna Clinic.

COVID-19 test-to-treat operations will be available at Amouli, Tafuna ACF1, and Leone Health Centers from 8AM-4PM on Monday-Wednesday, and 8AM-12 PM on Thursday. On Friday, tests will only be available at the Tafuna Health Center from 8AM-2PM. In Ta'ū, tests are available from 8AM-6PM from Monday to Friday, and from 8am-12pm on Saturday.
