EXECUTIVE ORDER 012 - 2022

AN ORDER TO REINSTATE PAY INCREMENTS INCREASES

Section 1: Authority

This executive order is hereby issued in accordance with the powers and authority granted to the Governor by Article IV, Sections 6 and 7 of the Revised Constitution of American Samoa, and the American Samoa Code Annotated, Section 4.0111 (b).

Section 2: Preamble

- WHEREAS, government employees who have satisfactory performance evaluations are entitled to a pay increment according to A.S.A.C. § 4.0409; and
- WHEREAS, Executive Orders 016-2010 and 007-2011 suspended pay increment increases as part of austerity measures that the government adopted; and
- WHEREAS, the Lolo administration reinstated pay increases but left the executive orders in place; and
- **WHEREAS**, this administration took remedial measures to give employees step increases to make up for prior years when pay increment increases were not given.

NOW THEREFORE, I, LEMANU P. S. MAUGA, Governor of American Samoa, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Revised Constitution of American Samoa and the American Samoa Code Annotated, hereby execute this order.

Section 1: Order

Executive Orders 016-2010 and 007-2011 are repealed. Any administrative guidance in conflict with this order is void.

Section 2: Effective Date

This order shall take effect immediately.
