This month's MAP reflects significant decreases across nearly all fuel products, driven by lower global benchmark prices and updated tanker outturns.

**Key Changes**

Mogas increases slightly by **\$0.02 per gallon**

These reductions provide meaningful relief for families, businesses, and government operations that rely heavily on diesel and aviation fuels. Although Mogas, which is primarily used for vehicles, increased slightly this month, the significant decrease in diesel is the key highlight due to its direct connection to utility costs for the community. With diesel dropping \$0.80–\$0.97 per gallon, this reduction should help lower ASPA's fuel surcharge to the public utility bill.

**Maximum Allowable Price (MAP)**

The MAP is published once per month, between the 1st and the 15th, and becomes effective on the 15th. MAP sets the maximum wholesale price that suppliers may charge their vendors. It does not control retail pump prices.

Most vendors typically receive contracted or discounted rates below the MAP, based on payment history, volume, and long-standing supplier relationships. MAP ensures suppliers cannot exceed the regulated ceiling price when selling to their vendors.

**Gas Station Survey:**

OPM conducted retail price surveys on June 14 and June 15 to observe how quickly pump prices respond to the significant MAP reductions. Despite diesel decreasing by \$0.80 to \$0.97 per gallon, retail diesel prices at nearly all stations remained unchanged during this period. Only Morris Scanlan Service Station adjusted its diesel price downward, while all other stations maintained their previous rates.

OPM will continue daily surveys to monitor when retail prices begin to reflect the lower MAP. OPM will also monitor, for internal records, if and when the lower MAP results in a measurable reduction to ASPA's fuel surcharge, and the extent of that impact.
