**General Description:**

- Manages correctional facility operations, such as inmate and staff schedules. Ensures the facility's safe operation and combines security, problem-solving, and prevention management strategically to ensure prevention and control.

**Key Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Supervise all prison staff for both juvenile and adults. Prison staff include Correctional officers, health care professionals, counselors, maintenance staff, and custodial staff.
- Determine staffing needs and allocate available staff accordingly.
- Ensure staff stays compliant by adhering to all laws, rules, and standards that Govern how prisons operate, as well as to the facility policies and procedures approved by the Warden.
- Oversee staff training and request routine data reports on training activity including delinquency on mandated recurring training.
- Investigate complaints or incidents to resolve inmate grievances.
- Supervise or conduct investigations of alleged inappropriate behavior and take disciplinary action, if deemed necessary.
- Ensure the facility and security equipment are properly functioning to keep staff safe.
- Manage budgets and monitor expenses appropriated for building and grounds upkeep, as well as significant health care, food services, and other costs.
- Maintains oversight of the operations and continually monitors performance within the division.
- Works closely with the department personnel for HR related matters.
- Develops and manages division budget and expenditures and ensures the timely application for community program funds.
- Perform other job-related duties as assigned.

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
