36 – CARPENTER

Minimum requirements: Education: 12th grade

Experience: One (1) year work experience

Wage rate: \$15.58 per hour; Overtime: \$23.37 per hr.

Duties: Construct, erects, installs and repairs structures and fixture of wood, plywood and wall board using carpenters hand tools and power tools, conforming to local building codes: Studies blueprints, sketches or building plans for information pertaining to the type of material required such a lumber or fiber board and dimension of structure of fixture to be fabricated. Selects specific type of lumber materials. Prepares layouts using ruler, framing square of clippers. Marks cut or assembly line on materials using pencil, chalk marketing gauge. Shapes materials to prescribed measurement using saws, chisels, and plans.

37 – CEMENT MASON

Minimum requirements: Education: 12th grade

Experience: One (1) year work experience

Wage rate: \$15.66 per hour; Overtime: \$23.49 per hr.

Duties: Smoothest/Finishes surfaces of poured concrete such as floors, walls, sidewalk, curbs to specified textures, using hand or power tools, including floats, trowels, and screeds soft concrete to specified depth and workable consistency, using float to bring water to surface and produces soft topping. Levels, smoothes, shape surfaces of freshly poured concrete, using straightedge and float or power screed. Finishes concrete using power tools trowels, and rubs concrete with abrasive stone to import finish. Lays concrete block and mixes cement using shovel, hand tools or mixing machines.

54 – HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

Minimum requirements: Education: 12th grade

Experience: One (1) year work experience

Wage rate: \$18.06 per hour; Overtime: \$27.09 per hr.

Duties: Operates several types of power construction equipment, such as compressors, pumps, hoist, derricks, cranes, tractors, scrapers, or motor graders, to excavate, move and grade earth, erect structural and reinforcing steel and pour concrete or other hard surface paving materials, turns valves to control air and water output of compressor pumps. Adjust hand wheels and depresses pedals to drive machines and control attachments such as blades, buckets, scrapers, and swing booms. Repair and maintain equipment.

3 – HEAVY EQUIPMENT MECHANIC

Minimum requirements: Education: 12th grade

Experience: Two (2) years work experience

Wage rate: \$19.60 per hour; Overtime: \$29.40 per hr.

Duties: Analyzes malfunctions and repairs, rebuilds and maintains construction equipment; such as cranes, power shovels, scrapers, paving machines, motor graders, trench-digging machines, conveyors, bulldozers, pumps, compressors, and pneumatic tools. Operates and inspects machines or equipment to diagnose defects. Dismantles and reassembles equipment, using hoists and hand-tools. Examines parts for damage or excessive wear. Replaces defective engines and subassemblies, such as transmissions. Tests overhauled equipment to ensure operating efficiency. Welds broken parts and structural members. May direct workers engaged in cleaning parts and assisting with assembly and disassembly of equipment.

***Special wage rate:** Work to be performed on DPRI-funded projects will be paid no less than (Carpenter \$15.58 per hour / \$23.37 overtime rate; Cement Mason \$15.66 per hour / \$23.49 overtime rate; Heavy Equipment Operator \$18.06 per hour / \$27.09 overtime rate; Heavy Equipment Mechanic \$19.60 per hour / \$29.40 overtime rate), but may be paid more where special Davis-Bacon Act rates apply.

Benefits: Roundtrip airfare for off-island hire; Lodging @ \$35.00 per week; Local transportation from employer's designated lodging facility to/from jobsite; Employer/Employee-paid medical insurance provided.

Successful applicant must be able to obtain military base access. Off-island hires must complete a pre-arrival and post-arrival health screening.
